St. John Catholic School School Advisory Council Financial Report

Operating Analysis - July 2021 through May 2022

School operations for the period July 2022 through May 2022 had a gain of \$19 thousand. Budget for the period was a loss of \$(218) thousand. Actual operating results were better than budget by \$236 thousand.

School operations on the whole were on budget, benefiting from higher donations and grants, and lower payroll and benefit expense.

On May 11, 2022, the School received a gift from the Diocese of Tulsa in the amount of \$103,880. The gift was made to help offset GO proceeds that had been expected, but not received.

Prior to receiving the gift from the Diocese, the lack of GO proceeds was offset by additional Endowment withdrawals over budget, and higher parish subsidies. In addition, the amount and the timing of the receipt of LHH and EANS State funding was not budgeted, helping operating results to be better than Budget.
